4. Board of Regents Report:

- Beginning in 2017, all PRNs will receive 90% of dues from members paid to ACCP. This is increased from 80% previously.
- ACCP's 2016 Clinical Pharmacy Competition for students has concluded with East Tennessee defeating Oregon State in the Finals. There was a record number of teams participating this year.
- ACCP's first Clinical Research Competition for students winner was Oregon State

- Dr. Olin updated the PRN on a current project that will use the PBRN to conduct a survey on the collaboration between clinical pharmacists and hospitalists. Dr. Olin serves as principal investigator and this project has been partially funded by the AMED PRN. The researchers are currently attempting to obtain IRB approval.
