3. Practice-Based Research Network (PBRN) Report:

  - a. Dr. Touchette gave a brief presentation on Strategic Plan for ACCP. Frontiers Fund: goal for this year raise \$100,000, to date \$35,000 donated. Encouraged all members to give to Frontiers Fund. Described Focused Investigator Training (FIT) program – flagship of ACCP Research Institute for researchers interested in NIH or similar type grants. Seventy-five investigators have completed the program with over \$7 million dollars in grant funding obtained within 3 years of graduating from program. Spoke of importance of PBRN and generating new knowledge for clinicians in practice. Encouraged members to join.

  - a. One hundred eighty-three students attended “Emerge from the Crowd” session for residency preparedness. East Tennessee State University won Student Clinical Skills Competition, with eleven other schools participating in competition throughout the meeting. In July, Board of Regents approved Student Chapters of ACCP. Twelve student chapters already approved. Encouraged other student chapters to formalize student chapters.
