 - i. Research Project: Collaborative Pharmacist/Hospitalist Survey
 - 1. Goals:
 - a. Characterize pharmacist/hospitalist collaborations
 - b. Determine barriers to successful collaborations
 - c. Develop a model for successful collaborations
 - 2. Started in November 2014 and using ASHP position on hospitalist/pharmacist collaboration from 2008 as the backbone
 - 3. Use survey results to create a model of care and develop a framework to develop this relationship
 - 4. Submitted this proposal to the ACCP Research Institute which accepted the concept and has been working with us to develop the survey and budget
 - 5. This would be the first PRN in ACCP to collaborate with the PBRN in developing a project like this
 - 6. ***Committee asked the PRN for \$4000 to cover cost associated with submitting IRB approval, and moving the survey to an electronic platform***
