Adult Medicine PRN Clinical Practice Award

To recognize excellence in adult medicine pharmacy clinical practice by an active member of the ACCP Adult Medicine PRN.

Eligibility Criteria

The Nominee should be an:

- ACCP member in good standing
- Adult Medicine PRN member in good standing
- Must be a minimum of five years beyond terminal degree.
- Must have an established career as an Adult Medicine Pharmacist Clinician with at least three years spent
 in an adult medicine related area of pharmacotherapy or an adult medicine related subspecialty pharmacy
 practice.
- Must have been a member of the Adult Medicine PRN for at least two years.
- Must have been actively involved in ACCP at the local or national level within the past three years (e.g., PRN Officer, Committee Member, Local Chapter Officer or Committee Member, Newsletter Contributor, Board Member, Event Chairperson, Speaker).

Nomination Submission Requirements:

- Updated curriculum vitae
- Two letters of recommendation from either
 - o Two ACCP Members

or

- One ACCP Member and one non-member who is a colleague or supervisor from the nominee's institution attesting to the clinical performance of the nominee.
- All letters of support should clearly document the nominee's contributions to the profession of pharmacy and any additional information that distinguishes the nominee.
- Individuals are able nominate themselves, but will need to have two letters of recommendation as stated above.
- Submissions that do not receive the award will be maintained for one year and reconsidered the following year.

This Awards Includes:

\$200 honorarium and recognition with plaque at Adult Medicine PRN business meeting at the National Annual ACCP Meeting

 August 3: Submission deadline nomination materials

August 24: Choose award winner and inform winners of award recognition
 October: Recognize award winners at Adult Medicine PRN business meeting
