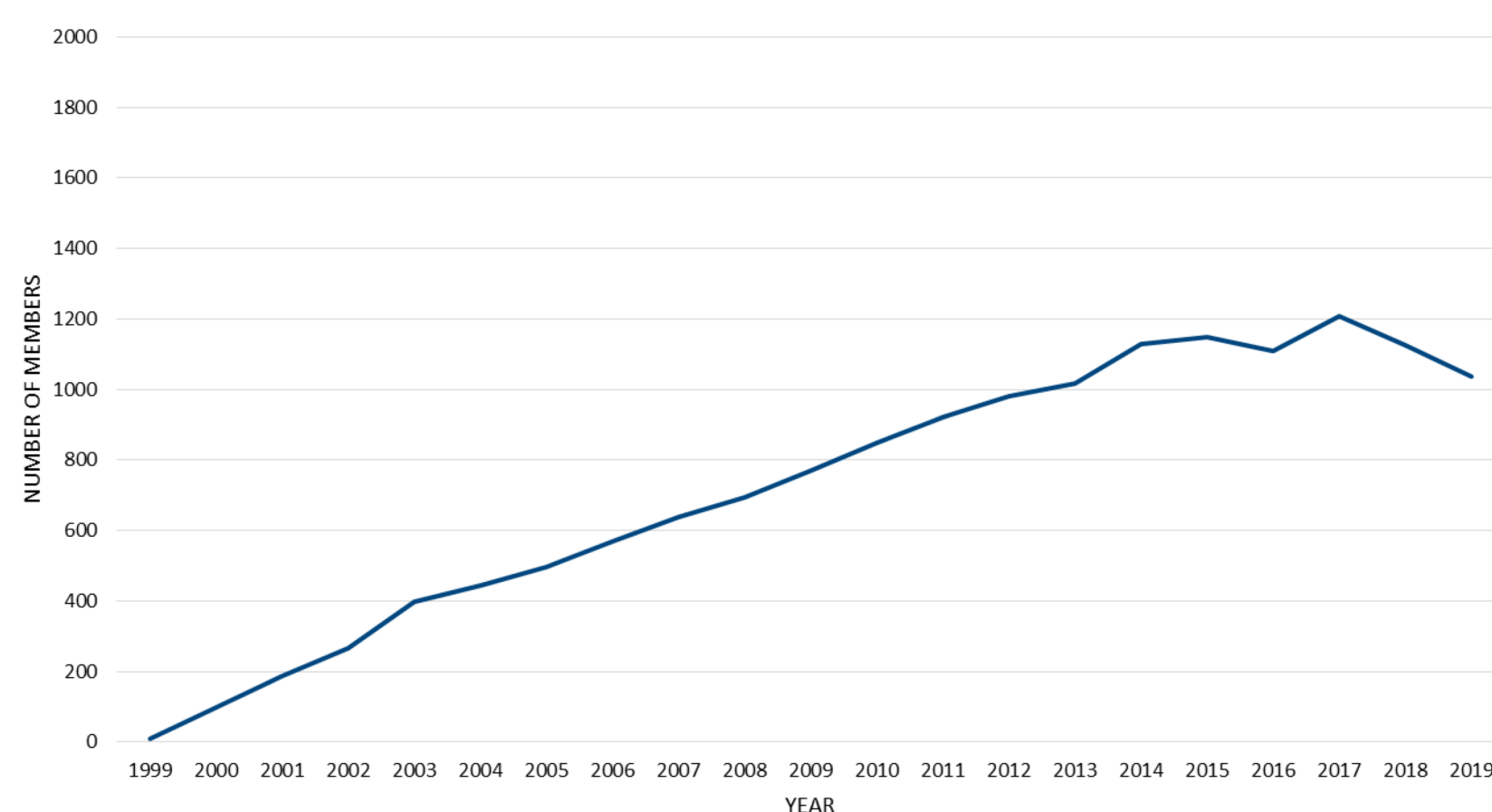
Objective

- Describe the membership, activities, and achievements of the ACCP Adult Medicine PRN

Membership

- Founded in 1999 at the Annual Meeting in Kansas City, MO with 10 members
- Over 1000 members in 2019
- 52 members have become ACCP Fellows
- 2019 Member Survey Results show:
 - 87% completed a PGY-1 residency
 - 53% completed a PGY-2 residency or fellowship
 - 92% are board certified in pharmacotherapy (BCPS)
 - 89% serve as preceptors
 - >40% are full-time faculty at a college of pharmacy
 - Members provide specialized/consult services in anticoagulation, nutrition support, pain management, diabetes, hypertension, dyslipidemia, transitions of care, antimicrobial stewardship, and pharmacokinetics
