- a. Dr. Touchette gave a brief presentation on the purpose of the PBRN, and efforts to collect practice setting data to better scientifically describe what clinical pharmacists do. The overall purpose is to enhance the visibility and recognition of clinical pharmacists as vital practitioners and researchers. He encouraged everyone to get involved, even if research is not their primary focus. In 2012, the PBRN will be working on the ACCP<sup>2</sup> study which will help document what is delivered by pharmacists in patient interactions.

Dr. Touchette clarified that from this point of studies moving forward, all clinician participants will be acknowledged as group authors.

- b. Dr. Dickerson described the Community Advisory Panel (CAP) which has 10 members from different practice areas. The panel reviews the feasibility and practicality of submitted protocols, and gives feedback to the PBRN. Nominations are open to become a CAP member. Deadline is October 31, 2012.
