

Adult Medicine PRN Outstanding Paper of the Year Award

The Adult Medicine PRN Outstanding Paper of the Year Award is for an outstanding contribution to the biomedical literature that is relevant to pharmacy practice in the area of adult medicine. The award will be given annually to the primary author of an important manuscript relevant to adult medicine pharmacotherapy published during the calendar year preceding the ACCP Annual Meeting at which the Award is presented.

Eligibility Criteria

The Nominee should be an:

- ACCP member in good standing
- Adult Medicine PRN member in good standing

Nomination Submission Requirements:

- Two letters of recommendation from ACCP members addressing the significance of the paper. At least one of the letters must be from an Adult Medicine PRN member. Letters from co-authors of the paper will not be accepted.
- Individuals are able nominate themselves, but will need to have two letters of recommendation as stated above.
- Eligible papers shall be nominated by an ACCP member who was not an author or member of the Adult Medicine PRN Nominations Committee. All papers will be evaluated and assessed based on classification, significance to adult medicine pharmacotherapy, methodology, results, and journal impact factor.

Award Includes:

\$200 honorarium and recognition with plaque at Adult Medicine PRN business meeting at the National Annual ACCP Meeting

Tentative Timeline:

- **June 15:** Announcement of awards being available to PRN
- **August 3:** Submission deadline nomination materials
- **August 24:** Choose award winner and inform winners of award recognition
- **October:** Recognize award winners at Adult Medicine PRN business meeting

All nomination materials should be submitted via email to Chairman of the Nominations Committee by August 3rd of each year. If this date is Saturday or Sunday, the nomination is due on the following Monday by 11:59 pm EST..
