

Adult Medicine PRN Distinguished Investigator Award

To recognize significant research contributions to the field of adult medicine pharmacotherapy by an active member of the ACCP Adult Medicine PRN.

Eligibility Criteria

The Nominee should:

- Be an ACCP member in good standing
- Be an Adult Medicine PRN member in good standing for at least two consecutive years
- Have met at least three of the four following additional criteria
 - Considered as an expert or leader in their field of adult medicine research with a record of independent research with outstanding contributions in basic pharmacology for clinical pharmacotherapy
 - An author of at least 5 original scientific publications in peer-reviewed journals
 - A recipient of competitive grant funding
 - Dedicated to mentorship and sponsorship of other investigators and clinicians.

Nomination Submission Requirements:

- Nominations may be made to the committee chair on an ad hoc basis or by submitting a letter of recommendation (see below). Individuals are able to self-nominate, but will need to have two letters of recommendation as stated below.
- Updated curriculum vitae including the following:
 - o Funding and Publication Record in adult medicine research
 - o Other forms of scholarship related to the area of research (e.g. review articles, invited seminars, textbook chapters, etc.)
- Two letters of recommendation which document the nominee's contributions to research in adult medicine (and any additional information that distinguishes the nominee) are required for consideration. Letters are accepted, but not required at the time of nomination. A maximum of two letters of recommendation will be reviewed by the committee. At least one of the letters must be from an Adult Medicine PRN member. Letters of recommendation from non-ACCP members (i.e. colleagues, supervisors, other health care providers) attesting to the research efforts of the nominee are welcomed, but only one of the two letters of recommendation may come from the institution of the nominee's current employment.
- Submissions that do not receive the award will be maintained for one year and reconsidered the following year.

Award Includes:

\$200 honorarium and recognition with plaque at Adult Medicine PRN business meeting at the Annual ACCP Meeting

Tentative Timeline:

- June: Announcement of awards being available to PRN
- August 3: Submission deadline nomination materials
- August 24: Choose award winner and inform winners of award recognition
- October: Recognize award winners at Adult Medicine PRN business meeting

All nomination materials should be submitted via email to the Chair of the Nominations Committee by August 3rd of each year. If this date is Saturday or Sunday, the nomination is due on the following Monday by 11:59 pm EST. Please contact the Chair of the Adult Medicine PRN Nominations Committee or the Adult Medicine PRN Chair with any questions or concerns.
